NDOT Updates / Best Practices

Staff from NDOT will provide information and updates pertinent to all transit managers.

FTA Updates

Regional Administrator Mokhtee Ahmad and FTA Region VII staff will give updates on FTA regulations and funding opportunities. This interactive session will allow discussion on issues provided by workshop participants.

Recognizing Drug Impairment

In this session, a representative from the Nebraska State Patrol Troop C will speak about recognizing drug impairment. Learn the warning signs of drug impairment in both drivers and passengers, get tips on how to safely address the issue of drug impairment as a transit manager, and hear examples of possible scenarios and best practices from a Nebraska State Patrol officer.

How To Positively Impact the Lives of Others
