

Nominations Being Accepted for NATP Board of Directors

If you are interested in serving on the Board of Directors send an email with your nomination and a short bio to the NATP office at jennifer@youraam.com by July 10, 2020.

In 2020, three officers will be elected. One officer will be elected from the NATP Western region and one officer from the NATP Eastern region. One at-large officer will be elected and may reside in any of the four regions.

To serve on the NATP Board of Directors, you must be a current member and a transportation provider. A transportation provider is defined as a public transit operator operating one or more vehicles.

- The western region includes the counties of Arthur, Banner, Box Butte, Chase, Cheyenne, Dawes, Deuel, Dundy, Garden, Grant, Keith, Kimball, Morrill, Perkins, Scotts Bluff, Sheridan, and Sioux.
- The eastern region includes the counties of Burt, Cass, Cuming, Dakota, Dixon, Dodge, Douglas, Gage, Jefferson, Johnson, Lancaster, Nemaha, Otoe, Pawnee, Richardson, Saline, Sarpy, Saunders, Thayer, Thurston, Washington, and Wayne.

The duties of the Board of Directors shall be to represent the best interests of the Association's membership, and to promote the Association's goals and purposes.

The NATP Board typically meets four times a year. Meetings are held in conjunction with a NATP event if possible; otherwise, meet via conference call for those not able to attend inperson. Meeting typically last one to two hours depending on the agenda items needing discussion.

Consider serving on the Board yourself or talk with a colleague to encourage them to submit a nomination.

NOTE: With the NATP bylaw changes, effective March 9, 2020, all nominations and ballots will be handled electronically this year.

April 15 – July 10	Nominations will be accepted
July 13	Nominee information and online ballot link will be sent via email
July 13 – July 28	Ballots will be collected via Survey Monkey
July 28	Ballots are due to the NATP office
August 5	Election results will be filed by the Board Secretary at the Annual Meeting
