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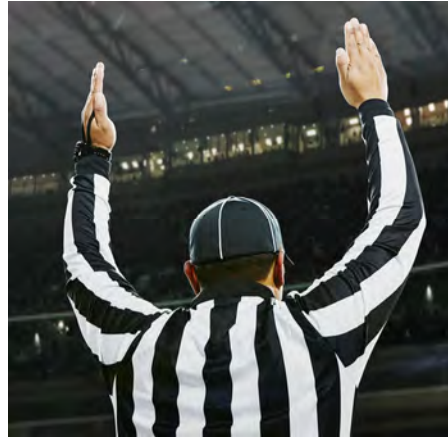

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
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## Technology

- So we will be asking for your input, the input of NDOT, other states, our partners, etc.



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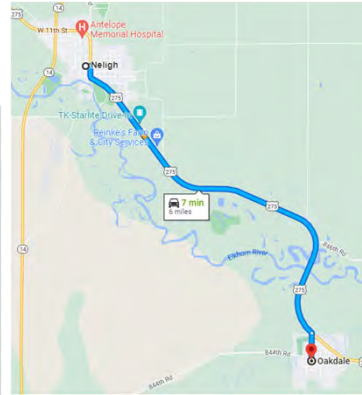
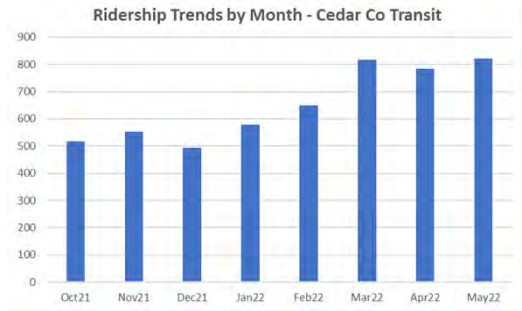

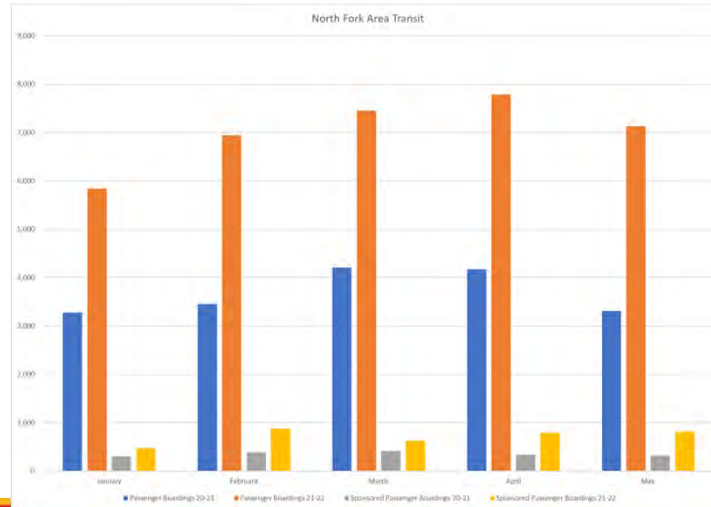
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# North Fork Area Transit
