

Safety Management Systems (SMS)

• What is it?

FTA's National Public Transportation Safety Program (PTSP)

It will improve public transit safety and provide agencies with a structure for understanding and addressing safety risks through proactive and timely organizational decision making.

SMS is a formal, top-down, organization-wide approach to managing safety risks and assuring the effectiveness of safety risk mitigations. This is the FTA's formal definition

How does it apply to Nebraska?

We need to make sure that everyone has access to information that is necessary to identify risks and ways to mitigate these risks. In new drivers' training we have added a section called SMS and we focus on how to recognize and identify risks and ways to mitigate these risks.

Veteran Drivers (>12 months)


